4.0 POLICY

4.1 Only the General Counsel or the Attorney General's Office may provide legal counsel to the University. All university employees seeking legal counsel for university matters should contact the Office of General Counsel, only after seeking approval from the appropriate dean, department head, vice president, the President, or appropriate member of the President's staff. The Office of General Counsel will assign legal matters to and consult with the Attorney General's Office as needed to provide legal services to the University. University employees should not contact outside counsel to provide legal services but should instead contact the General Counsel, who will engage outside counsel if needed.

4.2 The Office of General Counsel will comply with Board of Higher Education Policy R135. As the coordinator of legal affairs for the University, the General Counsel will assign legal matters to and consult with the Attorney General's Office in accordance with Regents Policy R135 and as needed to provide legal services to the University.

4.3 University trustees, officers, and employees should not contact or engage outside counsel to provide legal services to the University but should instead contact the General Counsel, who will engage outside counsel if needed.
