Issues/Concerns (including fiscal, legal, and compliance impact):

Physical contact is sometimes necessary for instructional, clinical, demonstration, assessment, or safety purposes. A policy governing necessary physical contact is needed to ensure that instructional touch occurs only when educationally necessary, is limited to the minimum contact required, and is conducted in a respectful, professional, trauma-informed, and consent-based manner.

Suggested Changes:

Create a new policy that outlines the following: general guiding principles of instructional touch, student-to-student instructional touch, required processes, alternative participation, high-risk activities, transparency, prohibited conduct, reporting concerns, and training.
